Check the website's security. Check for the lock icon next to the URL and that the URL shows "https". If there isn't a lock icon or a "s" after "http", it usually means it is unsecure.

Check your bank and credit card statements on a regular basis. Checking your statements will guarantee that unexpected charges won't go unnoticed. Identity theft signs can include: withdrawals from bank accounts that you can't explain, not getting your bills or other mail, foreign charges on your credit report, and new accounts you didn't open.
